

## Crundall Parish Council Grounds Committee: Meeting 1st February 2010

In attendance were Councillors Behagg (AB), Bredin (GB), Hebbbron (Chair) and Passmore (MP).

Actions shown in bold.

1. Apologies for Absence

No apologies were necessary.

2. Minutes of the Meeting of 18<sup>th</sup> January 2010

There had been a brief meeting on 18<sup>th</sup> January, due to the cancellation on 4<sup>th</sup>; the minutes had not yet been circulated. They would need to be agreed at the next meeting.

3. Matters outstanding from earlier meetings :

There had been a complaint to Hart about missing swings in Crundall; **GB would arrange early installation with MP.**

The cremation area work had been completed by John Brown (JB), although he had since decided that he needed to install an edging board.

GB was awaiting better weather before he replaced the seat on the aerial runway. He also commented that the step down boarding into landing pits was rotten and needed to be removed by JB, as potentially hazardous. We then needed to grade the earth surrounds; **CH to speak to JB about this.**

GB expected the facilities for toddlers at Ewshot to cost in the region of £600. This would need to be authorised by Council.

CH would ask the Clerk to chase Chuters re the church gate repairs for the East entrance.

AB confirmed that, after some investigation, the proposed cutting list for Rights of Way was acceptable. **This would be reported back to Council at the next meeting.**

4. Cricket charges

The response to our letter to the Cricket Club about extra matches indicated that there had not been any. Nevertheless, the committee believed that we should raise the fees for using Hook Meadow to a more realistic level. **AB would draft a letter about a meeting to discuss this.**

5. Replacement mower strategy

Following discussions with Cllrs Shelford and Argent, it had been **agreed that we seek three quotes. MP will progress.**

8. AOB

There had been some tree damage following the heavy snow. GB reported that he had seen none on Ewshot Recreation ground; there was some minor damage in Crundall. **CH would speak to JB.**
