

Crandall Parish Council Grounds Committee: Meeting 2nd November 2009

In attendance were Councillors Behagg (AB), Bredin (GB) and Hebbroon (Chair).

Actions shown in bold.

1. Apologies for Absence

Councillor Passmore (MP) made his apologies.

2. Minutes of the Meeting of 5th October

The minutes which had been circulated were accepted as a true record. They would be signed and passed to the Clerk.

3. Matters Arising from the Minutes of 5th October

None arising other than on agenda.

4. Replacement Swings – Hook Meadow and Ewshot Play Areas

GB would not be available for installation during the coming week; he confirmed that MP's "kit" was suitable. **GB & MP would liaise over installation**

5. Post Replacement Hook Meadow – Village Hall

The Chair had spoken to John Brown (JB), who would collect the post from Ewshot; he would also check whether he could dig a hole or would need help. JB would also obtain some ready mix concrete.

6. Crandall Tennis Court Maintenance

The committee realised that the moss treatment was a maintenance job, while the replacement net was a capital spend. Therefore the Chair had authority to proceed. He **would report this to Council at the next meeting.**

7. Cremation Area

The Chair said that Cllr Wilkinson was obtaining a quote via her gardener for gravel and membrane for installing a seat in the North end bed; it was suggested that JB could probably do this via the Travis Perkins account. **The Chair will speak to JB.**

8. Repair of Aerial Runway Tyre Seat – Ewshot Play Area

GB would locate a suitable seat and purchase.

9. Facilities For Toddlers Ewshot Play Area

This would be pursued alongside the replacement swing, by **GB & MP.**

10. Repair of Church Gates

It was agreed to **ask the Clerk to obtain quotes from the two contractors who quoted for the Pavilion door replacements.**

11. Repair of Pump Cricket Pavilion

It was agreed that the Chair ask the Cricket Club to **try to pursue recovery of costs from the original contractor.**

12. Football Pitch Subletting

This item should now **be removed from the agenda.**

13. Review of charges

Time precluded discussion, which would be done at the next meeting; **to include review of cricket charges.**

14. AOB

It was agreed that the parish would continue to rent a long reach hedge cutter rather than purchase one as this was the more economical option. **Action: GB**
