Minutes of Traffic & Lighting Committee Meeting 5th January 2009 at 7:45pm

1. Apologies
 - a. Nil
2. Minutes of previous meeting
 - a. Accepted.
3. Matters arising from previous minutes
 - a. Action 4.2 (HGV survey) – Pippa to progress
 - b. Action 4.3 (advise of HGV hotspots) – CD to progress
 - c. 5.1 – PW has letter from Mrs Ford Young, about closed part of church yard. The Church agrees that a tree can be planted, but without plaque. PW to speak to Mrs F-Y about closed Church Yard option. Clerk has list of trees and costs, expected to be borne by Mrs F-Y. A completely separate option was a tree outside Brandon Bungalows – which could have a plaque (if the tree was paid for by Mrs F-Y), but with a risk of vandalism. If Mrs F-Y was not disposed to these options, then the Parish Council would press ahead with a tree at Brandon Bungalows and close the matter relating to Mrs F-Y.
4. Five Year Plan Projects
 - a. Outline plan discussed to be circulated prior to next meeting.
 - b. Check SID software costs – DA.
5. Highway items – update
 - a. Light 10 in Crondall is intermittent.
 - b. Light 50 should not be re-positioned (outside village boundary).
 - c. Light 15. Land belongs to highways, up to owner to prove otherwise.
6. Tree planting – Brandon Bungalows
 - a. See above.
7. Village 30 scheme
 - a. Notice of 30mph limit has been circulated for consultation.
8. Relocation of 30 mph limit sign Well Road
 - a. No progress to date, despite promise that Hart would raise the necessary paperwork.
9. Removal of white lines – Pankridge Street
 - a. No progress.
10. Cutting of hedge near Crondall Stores
 - a. Raised with HCC, no progress over Christmas.
11. HGV/SatNav problems
 - a. CD has sent letter to Hart (Foggo) via Clerk.
