1. Apologies
 - a. Cllr Argent
2. Minutes of previous meeting
 - a. Accepted
3. Matters arising from previous minutes
 - a. CD village 30, done. Late start by Mott-Gifford, but now in progress.
4. Maintenance options and PFI Lighting Contract
 - a. PFI e-mail asking questions sent by DA, but no reply known. Action continues.
5. HCC traffic matters
 - a. Poor response from HCC
 - i. CD contacted Cllr Glen, who spoke to Steve Pallet better response promised Done. Encouraged us to speak to Pellet..
 - ii. DA has written to HCC (Pallet) to remind him about situation.
 - iii. Possible review approach to HCC to increase “touchy feely” nature of our interaction with them. Cllr Glen advised that the respond better to such and approach.
 - iv. No closure reports when jobs completed
 1. **Action:** CD to discuss with HCC.
 - b. Relocation of 30 mph limit sign Well Road
 - i. In addition to physical movement, will probably need paperwork to adjust limits.
 - c. Pankridge Street white line removal
 - i. No progress to date
 - d. Overhanging trees in Croft Lane
 - i. PW sent plans to Donald Richards, sent to Chris Corder who recommend that to address liabilities that owner have them re-inspected.
 - ii. HCC own report recommends annual inspection of Poplars that hasn't been done.
 - iii. Section 154 letter drafted and sent.
 - iv. Appears that trees may have been inspected.
 - v. **Action:** PW to e-mail HCC and ask if owners inspection has reported.
 - e. Pankridge Street Pavement
 - i. Barriers within 1 day, hole filled in within 1 week.
 - f. Redfields Lane tree branch
 - i. Cleared.
 - g. Pavement outside Crondall Lodge
 - i. No progress to date.
6. Village 30
 - a. 30 signs pack delivered for sticking on bins etc.
 - b. **Action:** GS to review. Probably make available to parishioners requesting + possible other locations. Garry to recommend next meeting.
7. Lorry activated signs
 - a. No action to date, continues – CD.

- b. Itchel Lane (just before top/fork in road, HGV limitation sign was replaced, but facing into village. Check direction and possible swivel round and tighten clamps.

 - b. Oak post outside The Castle has been ripped out of the ground.
 - i. **Action:** CD to report via e-mail to HCC.
 - c. Barry Cheesman reports that BT are trying to put extra poles in Dippenhall Street (to address low lines). Committee expects Conservation Area permission would be required.
